About The Organisation

Lift Up Voices is a registered provider of the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) and facilitates group workshops and individual sessions for people with disability. Our programs incorporate singing, movement, songwriting, recording, production and podcasting. Programs are modified according to the support needs and interests of each participant to maximise engagement and participation. Sessions adopt a client-centred and wholistic approach, which provide a unique opportunity for participants to develop skills in a highly motivating setting that can be transferred to other areas of their life.

About The Role

We are seeking a new Coach to join our team and be responsible for the planning and implementation of individual sessions and group workshops from our premises in Kent Town. Coaches work under the supervision of a social worker and Lift Up Voices directors, who will provide training for new hires to develop their skills and gain confidence in their work. Coaches provide a warm, supportive learning environment for participants and are required to promptly maintain case notes of each session. Following an initial probationary period, the successful applicant will have the opportunity to build their work hours as new participants are recruited to programs.

Essential Criteria

- Strong commitment to provide the best quality care and support for people with disability;
- Versatile musical skills, some of which may include vocal performance, songwriting, production and instrumentation;
- Well-developed communication and interpersonal skills including the ability to work and communicate effectively with participants, their families and other stakeholders;
- Willingness to receive ongoing feedback and commitment to continual improvement;
- Ability to work both independently and as part of a team;
- Current First Aid and CPR or willingness to obtain prior to employment;
- Willingness to undertake relevant background checks and undergo orientation training, including completion of the NDIS Worker Orientation Module 'Quality, Safety and You' prior to the commencement of work.

Desirable Criteria

- Tertiary qualification in Disability, Teaching, Music, Allied Health or similar;
- Experience in disability sector or similar field.
